



FPS BRIEFING NOTE

MINIMUM VOLUME OIL DELIVERIES

The minimum volume of heating oil and some other grades of oil that can legally be delivered by road tanker, using a mechanical meter, is 500 litres.

Modern road tankers deliver to the customer's storage tank via a sealed system, comprising a dedicated meter and hose. The meter system and component parts of the pipework have to be approved by National Weights & Measures under Statutory Instrument No. 1269: 2006 The Measuring Instruments (Liquid Fuel delivered from Road Tankers) Regulations 2006.

Part of the approval process is the specification of a minimum delivery volume. This is to do with the accuracy of the meter – below this volume, the meter is not sufficiently accurate to meet the requirements in the Regulations. Once the delivery system is installed on the tanker, it is sealed by trading standards officers using tamper proof seals.
